

2016 Home Performance with Energy Star Rebate Guide

Tip 1: Use the project list below to make sure your energy projects qualify.

Tip 2: Only use contractors from the Participating Contractors list.

Tip 3: Do not sign any other Xcel Energy rebate forms. Tell your contractors that you are in the Home Performance program.

Tip 4: Make sure to save all your receipts and invoices for your FREE post work inspection.

Important Details for the Home Performance Rebate Program

PAPERWORK

Remind your contactors NOT TO fill out any rebate paperwork for you. Rebate paperwork will be taken care of during your post work inspection by the Neighborhood Energy Connection. Call us to set up the appointment.

ATTIC INSULATION

Your attic should be insulated to at least R-50. However, if your existing attic insulation is greater than R-21, the contractor needs to add R-25 to the existing insulation. Achieving the correct R-value is a crucial part of earning the Home Performance rebate.

NON-ATTIC AIRSEALING AND WEATHER STRIPPING

This required project can be done by either you or your insulation contractor. You must air seal an area of your home <u>outside</u> of your attic. Common examples are: weather stripping exterior doors or air sealing your rim joist. Save applicable receipts and invoices to collect your rebate. Review your Audit Report to see where air sealing might be most effective.

LIGHTING

- In Home Performance, you must have at least 20 efficient lights in your house. This is the third required project. In addition to that project you can install additional lighting as a part of an elective lighting project.
- Between these two projects, you can install up to 20 new LEDs and 20 new CFLs. Xcel Energy will not give you a rebate for more than 20 bulbs of either type. Save your receipt for any new light bulbs that you purchase.
- For CFLs, you can earn \$1 per bulb. For LEDs, your rebate is 50% of the retail value of the bulb. Xcel Energy will only rebate LED bulbs, not fixtures with LEDs in them. The LEDs must use between 4-15 watts of energy.

PRE-EXISTING ITEMS

This allows you to count <u>one project</u> that was done before the audit as one of the five projects that must be completed in order to earn the Home Performance rebate.

- From the <u>required</u> portion of the list, only lighting can be pre-existing.
 - If you had at least 20 efficient bulbs in your home before your audit, you have met the requirements for this project.
- *From the <u>elective</u> portion of the list,* you may count only one project as pre-existing.
- Note that the pre-existing item will not count toward your rebate total; it simply decreases the number of projects you must complete.

HOME ENERGY SQUAD AND HOME PERFORMANCE

If you have had a Home Energy Squad Visit, some of the items they installed can help you complete Home Performance. Call the Energy Advisor Service to learn more about how to successfully combine these programs.
